Each student will undergo a comprehensive evaluation that explores their neurodevelopmental status, physiology, learning style, and emotional behavior wellbeing. A therapeutic and academic plan will then be designed for them, based on the evaluation.

"Our family, just like many families with special needs loved ones, believes breakthroughs are possible given the appropriate level of care in a unique and loving environment," said Vanessa Smith, Executive Director and Founder of Jeremiah's Promise. "Our school, following the Jacob's Ladder model, will provide a safe place to learn for anyone with atypical needs, no matter their age."
